
We are writing to inform you that a public hearing will be held on September 19, 2022 at 7:00PM with the Southborough Board of Health in reference to a Variance Request by under 310CMR15.411 for proposed soil absorption system at 16 Meadow Lane, Southborough, Massachusetts. The Variance is sought in order to allow the continued use of a municipal storm drain that begins in Meadow Lane and extends onto the subject property without benefit of an easement and placing the existing drain less than 100-feet from the proposed soil absorption system planned for 16 Meadow Lane, while 310CMR15.211 requires a 100-foot minimum setback through the use of an impermeable barrier equivalent environmental protection can be provided thus allowing the drain to remain in place.
