Non-Discrimination Notice of Rights

In accordance with the requirements of Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 ("ADA"), the Town of Southborough will not discriminate against qualified individuals with disabilities on the basis of a disability in its services, programs, or activities. The Town also does not discriminate on the basis of disability in its hiring or employment practices and complies with all regulations promulgated by the U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission under Title I of the ADA.

Modifications to Policies and Procedures: The Town will make all reasonable modifications to policies and programs to ensure that persons with disabilities have an equal opportunity to enjoy all of its programs, services, and activities.

Equal Access to Public Meetings: All Town-sponsored public meetings and hearings must be held in locations/formats that are accessible to persons with disabilities.

Effective Communication: Persons with disabilities who need either: (1) auxiliary aids and services for effective communication, or (2) written materials in alternative formats, or (3) reasonable modifications in policies and procedures, in order to access programs and activities of the Town of Southborough, are invited to make their needs known to program staff or to the Town's ADA Coordinator [i.e. the Town Administrator]. Requests should be made as soon as possible.

The Town will not place a surcharge on a particular individual with a disability or any group of individuals with disabilities to cover the cost of providing auxiliary aids/services or reasonable modifications of policy, such as retrieving items from locations that are open to the public but are not accessible to persons with a disability.
