Authority In Control: TOWN OF SOUTHBORO
Name of Highway(s): SOUTHVILLE ROAD

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

heroby adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Southboro

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

SOUTHVILLE ROAD - EASTBOUND

Beginning at the Westborough Town Line
Thence easterly on Southville Road

1.03 miles at 35 miles per hour
0.07 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at Cordaville Road.
The total distance being 1.10 miles.

SOUTHVILLE ROAD - WESTBOUND

Beginning at Cordaville Road
Thence westerly on Southville Road

1.03 miles at 35 miles per hour
0.07 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at the Westborough Town Line.
The total distance being 1.10 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
