Highway Location: SOUTHBOROUGH
Authority In Control: TOWN SOUTHBOROUGH
Name of Highway: OREGON ROAD

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Southborough

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

OREGON ROAD-EASTBOUND

Beginning at Woodland Road
Thence easterly on Oregon Road
0.74 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at the Ashland Town Line; the total distance being 0.74 miles.

OREGON ROAD-WESTBOUND

Beginning at the Ashland Town Line
Thence westerly on Oregon Road
0.74 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at Woodland Road; the total distance being 0.74 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
