PERMIT TO OPEN, OCCUPY AND OBSTRUCT PUBLIC WAY**

_____(a corporation having its usual place of business)
in the _____ hereinafter sometimes called the licensee, is hereby
authorized and permitted to open the surface and sub-surface of _____ a public way
in the Town of Southborough, for the purpose of _____ and in such
locations and for such distances as are shown on a plan attached hereto and made a part hereof, in
accordance with, and subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. No excavation authorized hereunder shall be more than three (3) feet in width nor more than five (5) feet in depth, except as hereinafter authorized under the provisions of paragraph 6 hereof. No excavation shall be of any greater length than is necessary to _____

2. During the course of the work permitted and required hereunder, all excavations and all materials removed from or to be installed in such excavations shall be properly fenced and fully lighted between the hours of sunset and sunrise during such time as said work remains uncompleted, and shall be protected at all times by such lighting, fences, warning signs, bridges and other materials as may be reasonably necessary to prevent inconveniences to others in the use of said way or of the property adjoining the same; and to make said excavations and materials removed therefrom, or to be installed therein, as safe as may be reasonably practicable to protect travelers and others on or near the way, from injuries or damage.
3. The surface and sub-surface of the way and the land within the limits of the way, shall be restored to the same condition, with the same similar types of material, as the same now is and shall be satisfactory to the Board of Selectmen and / or the Superintendent of Public Works.
4. All work authorized or required hereunder shall be done in such manner as to comply with existing statutes, Town By-Laws and rules and regulations of the Town _____ Department.
5. The Licensee shall install sleeves of sufficient size and strength of that pipes if any, installed and located beneath the surface of the way can be removed, repaired and replaced without disturbing the surface of the way.
6. Excavations larger than permitted in paragraph 1 hereof may be made if the Superintendent of Public Works shall give written permission therefore for the purpose of removing large stones or boulders which cannot be easily removed from such excavations otherwise.

7. All excavations made under the authority hereof, and all work required to be done hereunder, shall be completed on or before _____.
8. Upon completion of the work authorized and required hereunder, the Licensee shall, at its own expense, remove any excess or waste material from the area within the limits of the way.
9. The Licensee shall upon receipt of this authority, pay into the Town Treasury such sum of money as the Board of Selectmen shall determine to be the reasonable cost of inspection of the work permitted and required hereunder.
10. The Licensee shall pay into the Town Treasury such sum of money as the Board of Selectmen shall determine to be reasonably necessary to restore the surface and sub-surface of the way to its original condition, in the event that the Licensee shall fail to so restore said way, and such sum of money, or any part thereof, not required to be used by the town for such purpose, shall be repaid to the Licensee upon satisfactory completion of the work required hereunder.
11. The licensee shall indemnify and save harmless the Town from any and all loss, costs, damages and liability which may result to said Town from the performance of any work or act authorized or required hereunder, and for any breach of the terms and conditions hereof required hereunder, and for any breach of the terms and conditions hereof and for that purpose shall furnish to the Town a bond in the sum of _____ Thousand Dollars (\$____,000.00) with sureties satisfactory to the Board of Selectmen.
12. The authorization granted hereby shall not become effective until such bond has been approved and accepted by the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Southborough and the terms hereof have been accepted by the Licensee as evidenced by his signature or by the signatures of its President and Treasurer affixed hereto.
