Southborough residents are urged to attend Special Town Meeting on Monday, October 27 at 6:30 PM in the Trottier Gym (49 Parkerville Road) and vote on Article I — a key zoning amendment that will help secure our town's financial future.



Green checkmark

- ✓ Ease the burden on homeowners – Split more of the tax responsibility to commercial and industrial taxpayers.
- ✓ Bring in new revenue – A proposed Costco at 21 Coslin Drive could generate millions in tax dollars and attract other businesses.
- ✓ Strengthen local services – More commercial tax revenue means forming stronger partnerships, safer roads, and better public safety.
- ✓ Have a say – If approved, residents will still have input through public hearings on traffic, landscaping, and environmental impacts.

The Select Board unanimously supports Article I, calling it a crucial step toward rebalancing our tax base and protecting Southborough's financial stability.

Southborough residents are invited to safely dispose of unwanted materials during Household Hazardous Waste Day on Saturday, October 25, 2025, from 9:00am to 12:00 pm at the Southborough Public Works Yard. Items such as pesticides, pool chemicals, auto batteries, brake fluid, furniture polish & solvents will be accepted, while items like latex paint, alkaline batteries, motor oil & medical waste will not be collected. Please note that a valid Transfer Station sticker is required to participate, and fees apply for TV and computer monitor disposal.
